COMPREHENSION QUESTIONS

- What is the central theme of the story?
- Who are the characters in the book?
- What does the protagonist want to understand about God's love?

TEXTUAL EVIDENCE

- Can you find a line in the story that shows how the protagonist perceives God's love?
- How does the author use words and phrases to describe God's love?

INFERENCE AND INTERPRETATION

- Why does the protagonist ask about God's love in comparison to Mom and Dad's love?
- What do you think the author wants readers to understand about God's love?

PERSONAL CONNECTIONS

- How do you feel when you think about the idea of God's love?
- How can you relate to any of the situations the protagonist encounters in the story?

CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT

- How does the protagonist understand God's love change throughout the story?
- What qualities does the protagonist demonstrate while trying to show God's love to others?

IMAGERY AND DESCRIPTIVE LANGUAGE

- Can you find a line in the story that shows how the protagonist perceives God’s love?
- How does the author use words and phrases to describe God’s love?

MORALS AND VALUES

- What lessons about love and kindness can we learn from the story?
- How do the protagonist’s actions reflect the values of sharing, forgiveness, and humility?

CRITICAL THINKING

- Why do you think the author chose to use questions in the story?
- How does the author use nature and everyday experiences to illustrate God’s love?

CREATIVITY AND EXPRESSION

- What would it look like if you were to draw a picture representing God’s love based on the story?
- Can you come up with your own question about God’s love that isn’t in the book?

REAL-WORLD APPLICATION

- How can we apply the lessons from the story in our daily lives?
- Can you think of a time when you showed love and kindness to someone like the protagonist?

BONUS CLASSROOM ACTIVITY

- You may have noticed that *No Greater Love* is a rhyming book. Go on a rhyme hunt through the text. List pairs of words in the story that rhyme. Can you think of another word that also rhymes with each of your word pairs? Add these word family rhymes to your list too!
